Alcohol Prohibition Rule

Box 2

Rule: Students attending a basic law enforcement training course at the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center (KLETC) shall not possess, consume or be under the influence of alcohol from their arrival at KLETC each training week until their dismissal at the conclusion of each training week whether physically present on the KLETC campus or elsewhere during off-duty hours. Refusal to take a PBT test shall constitute conclusive evidence that a student has consumed alcohol in violation of this rule. This rule shall not be construed in any manner as prohibiting the possession or consumption of alcohol during the weekend period when not attending classes at KLETC. Students may consume alcohol-based medication while attending classes at KLETC only upon consultation with and prior written notification to their counselor or an administrative staff member. KLETC reserves the right to reschedule activities for any student who in a staff member's opinion cannot safely participate in the basic training course. **Penalty:** Because alcohol usage can seriously affect judgment, alertness, performance and conduct, compliance with this rule is critical to both the training process and the safety of students and staff. Although each case will be considered on its own merits and mitigating and extenuating circumstances will be taken into account, a violation of this rule in the KLETC training environment is considered to be an aggravating circumstance and likely to result in dismissal. Compelling circumstances may warrant imposition of a lesser sanction. **Rationale:** Students attending KLETC must understand that alcohol use is inconsistent with professional law enforcement activities. The basic training provided at KLETC as mandated by KSA 74-5604a has inherent risks associated with its delivery, and the use of alcohol elevates these risks. In simplistic terms the "no alcohol possession or consumption or be under the influence" rule is in effect for students during their entire basic training attendance at KLETC and away from the KLETC campus during the training week off-duty hours except for weekends when students return home.

Authorization to Release Records and Information

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Amendments Act; Voluntary Self-Identification and Disability

Box 4

The University of Kansas – Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center (KLETC) complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendment Act (ADAAA). In advance of arrival at KLETC to attend a law enforcement basic training class, any student officer with a disability who wishes to request reasonable accommodation in the class should provide KLETC documentation of the specific disability and a written request for any accommodation(s) the student seeks. It is a student officer's choice whether to voluntarily self-identify and disclose a disability in order to request accommodation. If disability documentation is provided to KLETC for review, the documentation must be completed by a recognized professional capable of diagnosing disabilities. KLETC considers all accommodation requests on a case-by-case review. When the student officer provides a request for an accommodation prior to the beginning of the class, KLETC and the student officer have an opportunity to engage in timely communications concerning accommodation that can be made without causing a substantial change or alteration of an essential element of the law enforcement basic training program, or posing a direct threat to the health and safety of others or an undue administrative burden on the program. When a request for accommodation comes after the class has begun it may be more difficult to make an appropriate accommodation in the time remaining in the class. A student officer's voluntary self-identification and disclosure of a disability can be made by accessing the KLETC website www.kletc.org – click on the Forms link and download KLETC Voluntary Self-Identification and Disability Disclosure Form. Instructions: Complete the form and mail with supporting documentation and specific accommodation request to Assistant Director, Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center, PO Box 647, Hutchinson, Kansas 67504-0647. Please label the mailing envelope as CONFIDENTIAL. Requests for accommodation will be reviewed as expeditiously as possible; however, given the short duration of many courses, some delay may be expected in course completion. I acknowledge that I have read the preceding ADAAA Voluntary Self-Identification and Disability Disclosure Notice, and I understand its contents.
