Firearms SAFETY Notice

To All Kansas Law Enforcement Agencies:

The Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center (KLETC) is aware of several reports of the Sig Sauer, P320, striker-fired pistol accidentally discharging during drop tests. Two videos are available that clearly demonstrate this occurring. Sig Sauer has issued a voluntary recall of its P320 pistol. Please see Sig Sauer website: <https://www.sigsauer.com/press-releases/sig-sauer-issues-voluntary-upgrade-p320-pistol/> for additional information.

Firearms safety is of paramount concern to KLETC staff. To help ensure the safety of staff and students we have issued a temporary prohibition of the Sig Sauer P320, striker-fired pistol from our Firearms Range and training activities. This temporary prohibition applies **only** to those Sig Sauer P320 pistols that have not been modified under the Sig Sauer voluntary recall.
