

Fentanyl Overdose: Death/Murder Investigations

This course touches on the history of the opioid epidemic and how we got to the current Fentanyl crisis. It focuses on the initial response to a possible Fentanyl overdose or death in the field, officer safety issues, what the initial first responders should do when responding to these scenes, and how to decide if a detective response is necessary. Participants discuss several case studies with successful prosecutions. Effective education methods in attempts to effectively combat and lower the overdoses in our communities are also presented in this course.

- Mexican drug trafficking organizations and their roll
- Initial patrol response
- Proper protective equipment
- How to process the scene
- Evidence location and collection
- Cell phone evidence
- Conducting a thorough death/murder investigation!
- Techniques to use to identify and track down the suspect who supplied the Fentanyl and effect an arrest.
- Best practices to utilize during the investigations.
- Preparing a solid case for prosecution in State or Federal court.
- Current Trends and future trends as they relate to emerging new synthetics.
